#### About our Nursery

The Nursery is a former doctor's surgery, which was converted some twenty years ago to become a small independent nursery school. In the early nineties the premises were re-registered to become a busy thriving Day Nursery and pre-school. King Edward Road Nursery will continue to offer day care alongside pre-school and holiday club for children aged 5-12 years. King Edward Road Nursery is part of the West Somerset Academies Trust.

Our Nursery has a comprehensive security system which comprises double entry doors with security passes.

The premises has undergone extensive renovation with the pleasing result of all rooms being light and airy. Inside the space has been arranged in such a way that that the children will be able to free flow whilst feeling safe and secure. We have a small integral multi-purpose/quiet room which staff will use for individual work with all the children.

Outside has a soft coloured play surface a covered area for picnics and a dual purpose butler sink to be used for hand washing or water play. Minehead Middle school has given nursery unrestricted use of the field opposite enabling the children to create opportunities to build dens, freedom to run and explore. Within this area is a natural garden tended by staff and pupils from the school, it is home to a number of insects and birds. It is filled with none toxic plants, fruit trees and bushes. All children will have the opportunity to spend time in this garden.



## Early years Foundation Stage

King Edward Road Nursery participates in the Governments Early Years Grant system which is administered by the local authority. These grants are available to all children aged between 3 and 5 years. In certain circumstances a 2 year old grant is also available. The nursery needs to achieve a rating of good or above from OFSTED to qualify for this scheme.

We accept all Employers' child care vouchers. Please advise the nursery manager which particular payment method will be used by your employer.

King Edward Road Nursery's philosophy and ethos is to provide the highest standard in Pre-school education and child care through a range of positive experiences, stimulating and exciting use of equipment with guidance for active learning from dedicated staff within a caring environment.

#### Key Person System

Each child will be assigned a Key Person to monitor their development and report progress to you during regular review meetings. Your child's Key Person will get to know all of their habits, routines and any other information which is important to you and your child.

#### Open Days

Will be held twice a year. All information will be displayed on the parent notice board between the double front doors and on the nursery's Facebook page.

# Training and Work Experience

In line with many local Nurseries, King Edward Road Nursery will participate in a planned programme of training and work experience to enable students to successfully complete the practical elements of child care courses. Inset training days will form an integral part of our staffs continued professional development.

#### Fees

We are open from Monday to Friday, all year round, from 7-45am until 6.pm.

#### Age 0-2 years:

Full day £43.00

Morning (8am - 1pm) £21.50

Afternoon (1pm - 6pm) £21.50

Day session (8am - 3pm) £30.10

#### Age 2-3 years:

Full day £42.00 Morning (8am - 1pm) £21.00 Afternoon (1pm - 6pm) £21.00 Day session (8am - 3pm) £29.40

#### Age 3-5 years:

Full day £40.00 Morning (8am - 1pm) £20.00 Afternoon (1pm - 6pm) £20.00 Day session (8am - 3pm) £28

7.45am - 8 am can be arranged at an additional cost of £3.00



#### **Payments**

Invoices will be raised for the first of the month with payment due by standing order or direct debit settlement within five working days. Additional hours will be shown on your invoice for immediate payment.

#### **Debt Recovery**

King Edward Road Nursery will actively support the family whilst they have outstanding debt. However, it needs to be made clear that the Nursery can neither afford nor tolerate debts for long periods. Further details of our Debt Recovery policy, and other policies, are available in our Policy Documents and Staff Handbook held in the Nursery or on the nursery web-site

#### Snacks and Meals

Healthy snacks are included in the fees, but if you wish to share any surplus fruit or vegetables from your garden or allotment we would be very grateful. Staff would then link this to active learning. Children can bring in a cold packed lunch or Nursery can provide a hot nutritious meal at a cost of £1.85 per day, this is only available in the term time. Most special dietary needs can be met. Milk feeds are not included.

#### Holidays

The Nursery will be closed for one week over Christmas and New Year and all statutory Bank Holidays. Charges will not of course be incurred for these periods.

Any absence including illness must be paid for in full.
